Housing

A block of rooms for the Annual Meeting has been reserved at the Stowe Mountain Lodge (7412 Mountain Road, Stowe, VT 05672). Rooms are available on a first-come, first-served basis at a special room rate of \$249 per night (plus state and local taxes) for single or double occupancy. This rate is guaranteed through **Tuesday**, **July 1**, **2014**. All housing cancellations need to be made 7 days prior to arrival, or the one night's room and tax deposit will be forfeited.

Travel

Air Travel: IDSOG's official travel agent is Gant Travel Management, available toll-free at 1-800/621-1083 (1-630/227-3873, outside US/Canada). Gant is available 8:00am - 5:00pm CST, Monday through Friday. A \$25 service fee is issued per airline ticket.

Ground Transportation: The Stowe Mountain Lodge is located 45 minutes from the Burlington International Airport (BTV). Taxi fare to/from the hotel will cost approximately \$85 each way. The current IDSOG Council gathered in January to formulate a 3-year strategic plan to set specific and measurable goals for the Society. Review the full strategic plan at your convenience, and below are some of the highlights.



Our priorities over the next three years consist of goals regarding membership, finance, communications, and governance. The top three priorities that are currently underway include the following:

- Design and launch a legacy development program
- Grow the net profit of the annual meeting
- Grow the membership by 15% a year over the next 3 years
- Review the bylaws to current and best practices for review at the 2014 Annual Business Meeting.

In addition to identifying these objectives, in addition to others listed on the document reference above, the Council also outlined specific strategies and tactics to assist in accomplishing these goals.
